



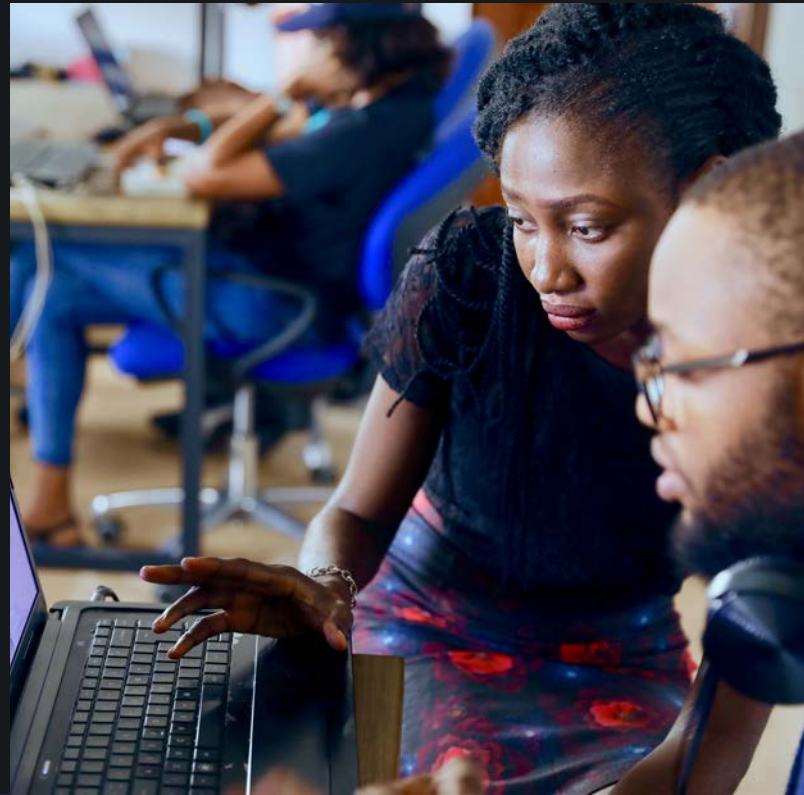
Internship Placement
