Fees

Registration Fee

A one-time fee per booking to cover all administration costs, payable for all courses unless specified.

Accommodation Placement Fee

Added to all bookings where the student has booked any accommodation in the LAL Price List to cover all administration costs.

Change Fee

- May be charged after the student has arrived at the school and wants to make a change which relates to either the course or the accommodation.
- Change fee is waived where the student is making a change which is more expensive, e.g. lengthening a course or changing to a more expensive course or LAL accommodation.

Course Materials Fee

- Not chargeable for Private Tuition.
- Where a student has booked two courses which use a different book, e.g. General English + IELTS, two course book fees will be charged.
- Where students stay for more than 8 weeks, they will be charged in-school for further course material fees, if required (e.g. a student does nine weeks and does not change level so will not be charged in school).

Exceptions are:

- IELTS
- ESP

Only one fee to pay, regardless of the length of study.

Document Courier Fee

- Charged where the student or third party requires the original copy of a document such as a visa letter or form, or a certificate.

Flight Delay

Covid-19

Key Information

All courses are continuous enrolment. Students aged under 18 booked on "adult" courses are subject to additional terms and conditions:

- Respect the evening curfew
- Book accommodation which is listed as 16 or above as a minimum age
- Book half or full board (no bed and breakfast) (except for Cape Town)
- Have our online welfare and consent form completed by a parent or legal guardian
- Have health insurance and produce it on arrival at the school
- No drinking or smoking or purchasing alcohol or cigarettes
- Sign in and out of the school daily
- If accommodation is not arranged by LAL, parents must complete our online consent form which states where the student will be staying, with whom and a copy of the parent/legal guardian's ID document will also be needed.

N.B. There is no included afternoon leisure package for students if they book an English course which is not a Young Learner programme. Each school has a number of activities and excursions which the student can book on-site.

Tuition

General English

- Courses of 15 hours per week usually take place in the morning, though in peak periods, they occasionally take place in the afternoon.
- English for 30+ comprise 15 hours' General English in the school with a bespoke package in the afternoon/evening for the 30+ group only.
- Afternoon English cannot be taken with any of the supplementary courses.

English for Work

- All Special Courses can be booked for groups of 6+ throughout the year.
- Students can join the Special Courses at any stage during the course dates as the courses do not require participation from the start.

Accommodation

Homestays

- Arrivals or departures outside our transfer days on request, though unlikely during High Season.
- Arrivals outside the check-in times for homestays may either pay a supplement or be asked to book a hotel for one night if arrival is later than the check-in times.
- Availability at homestays at Christmas and New Year are extremely limited.
- Special diets means:
 - » Vegan
 - » Celiac (gluten-free)
 - » Lactose free
 - » Halal on request, though we cannot guarantee offering this option.

Cape Town Residence

- On occasion, students may be asked to change rooms during their stay. Advance warning will be given.

Work Experience & Internships

General

- Lead time of at least 8 weeks needed between initial enquiry and acceptance.
- Students must book at least one week's tuition for Cape Town.
- The tuition must take place before the placement.
- All placements are unpaid.
- Further detailed information is available on our website.

Transfers

General

- Where transfers are "any time", you will need to make sure that your arrival time is within check-in times for your accommodation.
- LAL representative, as described below, may also be the private vehicle driver.
- If you do not take up our transfers with LAL, we still need to know arrival flight details if you have booked LAL accommodation.
- Students under the age of 18 must book an LAL transfer, unless waived by their parents.

Shared Transfers

- Comprise public transport, LAL or LAL leased vehicles or private vehicles with other LAL students.
- Operate according to the operator's timetable or when LAL has accepted the allocated students onto their contracted vehicle.
- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative

Private Transfers

- Private vehicles with the student or students who booked the transfer.
- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative.

Insurance

Covid-19

PLEASE NOTE: Due to preventative measures and operating and government restrictions surrounding COVID-19, it may be necessary for LAL Language Centres to make changes to its usual planned events and activities, including cancellation.

Please also note that if you or a fellow student/contact displays signs of COVID-19, it may be necessary under government law for all contacts to self-isolate/quarantine for a period of time, as advised by the UK or South African government. In such cases, online lessons will be offered. If the period of self-isolation/quarantine requires an extension of accommodation, all incurred expenditure including meals and food shopping shall be the responsibility of the student, not LAL Language Centres or the homestay provider.

LAL Language Centres strongly urges all students to carefully check their insurance policies to fully understand the cover and the potential for incurred expenses in the event of cancellations.

LAL's insurance provider is guard.me international insurance. The guard.me "Multi-risk plus Cancellation" insurance will include medical cover for COVID-19 but not trip cancellation costs for COVID-19 as it is no longer an unexpected event. This means that costs incurred to extend accommodation due to isolating or quarantine will also not be covered by insurance and will be the responsibility of the student.

Tuition

- Qualified teachers (native or native-level*)
 - 15 hours' English tuition as a minimum each calendar week
 - Torbay operate a weekly zig-zag timetable during the summer (July and August) when numbers are high
 - Other schools may operate zig-zag timetables when numbers are high
 - Zig-zag means one week lessons in the morning, the following week, lessons in the afternoon
 - Students on 1 week courses and Family Programmes will usually have lessons in the morning, although this is not guaranteed

Damage Deposits

- A damage deposit is required for all UK Summer Schools for all students for all accommodation types
 - The amount is payable in cash on arrival and is handed back on departure only
 - Damage deposits are handed back when the student has vacated the room and handed back any key they may be given
 - The amounts are:
 - UK: £60 or €80
 - Cape Town: ZAR 500 or €35
- (in small notes as we may not be able to give change)
- Where loss or damage has been agreed, LAL will supply an invoice/receipt for the transaction

Accommodation & Meals

General

- Students may not be able to occupy their rooms on arrival due to cleaning turnaround
- Meals are provided on arrival at the school/ accommodation
- No meals are provided for the transport between the airport and the school – this is important for Torbay as the transfers are around 5 hours
- Late arrivals (after 19.00) may only be offered cold meals such as a sandwich
- Where meals are provided on the day of departure, only **one** packed meal for the journey home will be supplied (e.g. packed breakfast for an early departure)
- Students are allocated with students from other countries or language where possible
- If a student has a particular sharing request, this must be supplied in writing at least two weeks prior to the arrival of the student
- Sharing requests cannot be guaranteed
- All accommodation changes, including room changes in residence, are to be undertaken and authorised by LAL. No student should change room without that authorisation

Excursions & Activities

- All excursions are accompanied by LAL activity staff
- LAL activity staff are not qualified guides
- Information will be given to students about the destination
- Transport will be private vehicle or public transport
- Optional excursions are offered at some of our schools – please see our website for more information
- Optional excursions can be booked and paid for in advance or on-site on arrival
- Optional excursions are based on minimum numbers so may not go ahead
- Students are given free time during some of our excursions (see Free Time and Leaving Campus Policy for information on students under 12)
- Activities usually take place on-site and are led by LAL staff
- In Cape Town, most activities take place off-site and are led by LAL staff

Unaccompanied Minor

- Airlines require students to be booked as an unaccompanied minor where they are under a certain age. This varies from airline to airline so please check with the airline and make sure payment is made for the return trip
- Parents may decide to take the service even if the airline does not require it. In this instance, they can choose arrival or departure only or both journeys
- LAL's fee is in addition to any fee that is paid to the airline
- If multiple students (maximum of six) travel together on the same flight, we will make only one charge

Transfers

General

- LAL representative could be the driver
- All third party companies providing transport services on behalf of LAL are checked for their suitability to work with under 18s
- If a student is not using our transfer service, LAL still needs the flight details for both arrival and departure and will need the name and contact number of the person dropping off and/or collecting their child.
- LAL arranges students to be at airports at least two hours before departure. Requests to be at the airport significantly earlier may not be granted or may require further supplement

Shared Transfers

- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative
- Public transport, LAL or LAL contracted vehicles or in private vehicles with other LAL students.
- Depending on arrival, students may have to wait at the airport for the next available vehicle to take them to the school. They are supervised by an LAL representative
- Operate according to the operator's timetable or when LAL has accepted the allocated students onto their contracted vehicle

Special Transfers

- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative
- Private vehicles with the student or students who booked the transfer
- Price only valid for student bringing one suitcase. If a second suitcase is brought, then a supplement may be applied for a larger vehicle

Homestays

General

- Visitors to homestays are only allowed by arrangement with the host
- Students are not allowed to cook
- Students are not allowed to smoke
- Students must not use the landline/fixed telephone
- Curfews are in place
- Where a student is placed in shared rooms, we cannot guarantee that there will be another student available to share

Torbay

- Students have breakfast and evening meals with the homestay
- A packed lunch will be provided
- Sunday is a free day from lessons and excursions
- Students over 12 travel to and from school on foot or using public transport
- Students can buy bus tickets if they wish
- Students 12 and under are transported to and from the school in private vehicle
- As we transport the younger students to and from school, we usually place them further away from the school
- Long stay supplement
- Additional safeguarding checks must be made to the homestays for any students under 16 years old staying for more than 27 nights
- These checks are conducted by Torbay Council Children's Services and are mandatory
- Additional paperwork is also required for the student's parents/guardian to complete.
- The costs for this covers the fees for the additional safeguarding checks

Cape Town

- Students have breakfast and evening meals with the homestay
- Lunch is served at the school

Free time & leaving the campus

All Programmes
