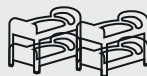

All courses are continuous enrolment. Students aged under 18 booked on "adult" courses are subject to additional terms and conditions:

- Respect the evening curfew
- Book accommodation which is listed as 16 or above as a minimum age
- Have our online welfare and consent form completed by a parent or legal guardian
- Have health insurance and produce it on arrival at the school
- No drinking or smoking or purchasing alcohol or cigarettes
- Sign in and out of the school daily
- If accommodation is not arranged by LAL, parents must complete our online consent form which states where the student will be staying, with whom and a copy of the parent/legal guardian's ID document will also be needed.

N.B. There is no included afternoon leisure package for students if they book an English course which is not a Young Learner programme. A number of optional activities and excursion can be booked at the school.

Students enrolled in the Flexi option will be assigned to either morning or afternoon lessons according to the school's scheduling and classroom availability. Lesson times cannot be selected by the student. Subject to availability.
- Intensive English: This course is 22.5 hours per week -15 hours per week (morning lessons) and 7.5 hours per week (afternoon lessons)

Real Life English +

- All Special Courses can be booked for groups of 6+ throughout the year.
- Students can join the Special Courses at any stage during the course dates as the courses do not require participation from the start.

Accommodation

Homestays

- Arrivals or departures outside our transfer days on request, though unlikely during High Season.
- Arrivals outside the check-in times for homestays may either pay a supplement or be asked to book a hotel for one night if arrival is later than the check-in times.
- Availability at homestays at Christmas and New Year are extremely limited.
- Special diets means:
 - » Vegan
 - » Celiac (gluten-free)
 - » Lactose free
 - » Halal on request, though we cannot guarantee offering this option.

School Residence

- On occasion, students may be asked to change rooms during their stay. Advance warning will be given.

Volunteering

General

- Lead time of at least 4 weeks needed between initial enquiry and acceptance.
- All placements are unpaid.
- Further detailed information is available on our website.

Transfers

General

- A complementary arrival transfer is only provided for direct journeys between Cape Town International Airport and LAL Student Residence, LAL Student House, or Host Homes arranged by LAL. This complimentary service is non-transferable, cannot be redeemed for cash, and cannot be swapped for a free departure transfer if it remains unused.
- Where transfers are "any time", you will need to make sure that your arrival time is within check-in times for your accommodation.
- LAL representative, as described below, may also be the private vehicle driver.
- Students who have booked LAL accommodation must provide their arrival and departure flight details, even if airport transfers have not been arranged through LAL.
- Students under the age of 18 must book an LAL transfer, unless waived by their parents.

Shared Transfers

- Comprise public transport, LAL or LAL leased vehicles or private vehicles with other LAL students.
- Operate according to the operator's timetable or when LAL has accepted the allocated students onto their contracted vehicle.
- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative

Private Transfers

- Private vehicles with the student or students who booked the transfer.
- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative.

Insurance

- Students aged 16 or 17 on adult courses must have health insurance. Proof of this must be provided on arrival and students will have to purchase on-site if they do not have it.
- LAL's optional travel and medical insurance for students has a maximum age of 64. See school pages for each school's premium.
- Insurance cards are sent out between 1 and 2 weeks prior to arrival.

Key Information

- If a student is over or under the age range published, an online waiver must be completed
- Students can stay for a minimum of 1 week and a maximum of 4 weeks
- Courses longer than 2 weeks are on request, but aspects of the programme may be repeated
- Arrivals outside the transfer days are limited and on request only and subject to a supplementary cost
- Changes to the programme cannot be made to individual students
- Changes to the programme for groups only allowed by written mutual consent with at least two weeks' notice
- Requests cannot be guaranteed during High Season
- All students are required to register on arrival. There may be a waiting period at peak arrival times
- Students not allowed to smoke or consume alcohol at any time

Tuition

- Qualified teachers (native or native-level*)
- Hours vary depending on course chosen
- LAL Cape Town may operate zig-zag timetables when numbers are high
- Zig-zag means one week lessons in the morning, the following week, lessons in the afternoon
- Students on 1 week courses and Family Programmes will usually have lessons in the morning, although this is not guaranteed
- Students on 3 week courses will usually have 2 weeks of lessons in the morning, although this is not guaranteed

Accommodation & Meals

General

- Students may not be able to occupy their rooms immediately on arrival due to cleaning turnaround
- Meals are provided on arrival at the school/ accommodation
- No meals are provided for the transport between the airport and the school
- Late arrivals (after 19.00) may only be offered cold meals such as a sandwich
- Where meals are provided on the day of departure, only **one** packed meal for the journey home will be supplied (e.g. packed breakfast for an early departure)
- Students are allocated with students from other countries or language where possible (not guaranteed)
- If a student has a particular sharing request, this must be supplied in writing at least two weeks prior to the arrival of the student
- Sharing requests cannot be guaranteed
- All accommodation changes, including room changes in residence, are to be undertaken and authorised by LAL. No student should change room without that authorisation

Excursions & Activities

- All excursions are accompanied by LAL activity staff
- LAL activity staff are not qualified guides
- Information will be given to students about the destination
- Transport will be private vehicle or public transport
- Optional excursions are available. Please contact school staff to explore these options.
- Optional excursions can be booked and paid for in advance or on-site on arrival
- Optional excursions are based on minimum numbers so may not go ahead
- Students are given free time during some of our excursions (see Free Time and Leaving Campus Policy for information on students under 12)
- Most activities take place off-site and are led by LAL staff

Unaccompanied Minor (UM)

- Airlines require students to be booked as an unaccompanied minor where they are under a certain age. This varies from airline to airline so please check with the airline and make sure payment is made for the return trip
- Parents may decide to take the service even if the airline does not require it. In this instance, they can choose arrival or departure only or both journeys
- LAL's fee is in addition to any fee that is paid to the airline
- If multiple students (maximum of six) travel together on the same flight, we will charge only one UM fee

Day/Family Programmes

For any Day Programme, parents must complete our online consent form which states where the student will be staying, with whom and a copy of the parent/guardian's ID document will also be needed.

Day Programmes

What is included:

- Tuition Only
 - Placement Test & School Induction
 - 15 hours' English per week
 - Course Material
 - Certificate of Attendance
 - Report (on request)
- Daytime
 - Same as Tuition Only, plus:
 - Lunch 5 days per week
 - Half day excursion/activity on days where lessons take place
 - Supervision by LAL staff
 - Two free days per week to spend with family or friends
- Daytime + Evening
 - Same as Daytime, plus:
 - Dinner Mon-Fri
 - Evening leisure programme (4 nights per week)
- Full Programme
 - Same as Daytime + Evening, plus:
 - Full day excursion on Saturday
 - Lunch and Dinner on Saturday

Free time & leaving the campus

All Programmes

- Students are given free-time in groups of at least 3 when on excursions (students under 12 are fully supervised by LAL staff or group leaders)
- Parents who want to visit and/or remove their children for a day or overnight must give LAL at least 24 hours' notice and bring valid photo ID
- Where a nominated person is to visit or remove a student from the campus, written notice must be sent to LAL along with a copy of the parent or legal guardian's valid photo ID
- Students are not allowed to leave the campus during their free time if they are not in a minimum group of 3 students, or with their Group Leader or an LAL staff member
- Students are not allowed out of the residence after 22.00

Damage Deposits

- The amount is payable in cash on arrival and is handed back on departure only
- Damage deposits are handed back when the student has vacated the room and handed back any key they may be given
- The amount is ZAR600 or €30
(in small notes as we may not be able to give change)
- Where loss or damage has been agreed, LAL will supply an invoice/receipt for the transaction

Transfers

General

- LAL representative could be the driver
- All third party companies providing transport services on behalf of LAL are checked for their suitability to work with under 18s
- If a student is not using our transfer service, LAL still needs the flight details for both arrival and departure and will need the name and contact number of the person dropping off and/or collecting their child.
- LAL arranges students to be at the airport approximately three hours before departure. Requests to be at the airport significantly earlier may not be granted or may require further supplement

Shared Transfers

- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative
- Public transport, LAL or LAL contracted vehicles or in private vehicles with other LAL students.
- Operate according to the operator's timetable or when LAL has accepted the allocated students onto their contracted vehicle

Special Transfers

- Student will be met in the Arrivals Hall by an LAL staff member or representative
- Private vehicles with the student or students who booked the transfer
- Price only valid for student bringing one suitcase. If a second suitcase is brought, then a supplement may be applied for a larger vehicle

Homestays

General

- Visitors to homestays are only allowed by arrangement with the host
- Students are not allowed to cook
- Students are not allowed to smoke
- Students must not use the landline/fixed telephone
- Curfews are in place
- Where a student is placed in shared rooms, we cannot guarantee that there will be another student available to share
- Students have breakfast and evening meals with the homestay
- Lunch is served at the school
- Packed lunch is prepared by the school for full day excursions
- Sunday is a free day from lessons and excursions
- Students over 12 travel to and from school on foot or using public transport
- When an activity ends after 21.30, a shared taxi is provided by LAL to get the student home. (shared with other students)

Insurance

- Where a group is sent with a group leader, the leader is also covered by the same insurance

- Maximum age 64 on the first day of travel.

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
